Matthew and Eric Gilbertson are fraternal twin brothers who have hiked the Appalachian Trail, biked from Alaska to Montana, and climbed the highest mountain in all 50 US states. They're currently working on the ultimate peakbagging list - the 196 country high points. They hold PhD degrees in Mechanical Engineering from MIT.
