

In <u>The</u> <u>Wild Places</u>, MacFarlane sets out to answer the question– 'are there still untouched, wild places?' As explorers, many of whom work in measuring, countering, or preventing human damage to the environment, this simple question is at the back of our minds too. How far must we go in order to find "The Wild"? When are we off the map? Where be the dragons?

MacFarlane's whimsical personality shines through, as he begins the book by climbing a tree and, shortly after, with some fence climbing in the middle, sails a boat to a remote island on a whim–and this is just in the first several pages!
