Week 5 Meeting: Kiko Matthews Resilience and Rowing the Atlantic Solo

In 2018, Kiko Matthews set a world record by becoming the fastest woman to row solo and unsupported across the Atlantic Ocean (in 49 days), after recovering from brain surgery only months earlier. Since then, she has completed an ultramarathon in Jordan and worked with local communities on beach conservation while cycling the UK coast. She will be speaking about the life skill of resilience, drawing on her personal adventures and experiences.

Wilderness with Simon Reeves

There is a hesitancy in professional exploration circles to admit our interest in easily digestible adventure media made for a public audience. However, as a counterpoint, how many of us were inspired to take up our current fields of interest by Sir David Attenborough or Dame Jane Goodall? Science communication is a vital part of any expedition. While Attenborough and Goodall leave some oversized boots to fill, I think Simon Reeves may be up to the task.

Reeves has been a travel television presenter since 2001, and a conservationist since 2006. Although he's written several books, created heaps of TV specials, and even a few awards, it is his most recent series that finally caught my attention. In "Wilderness" Reeves takes viewers to four unique, remote locations. Yes, some of it seems staged and an all too familiar dramatic score gives the series an "edgy" vibe casual consumers of edutainment, but it is Reeves' own sincerity that sells the show. Whatever happens in post, you can see his excitement, respect, and humility when he interacts with communities and environments. In one hand, he has the genuine wonder of a child discovering the world for the first time, while in the other, the honest care that he has is evident in his every interaction.
