Australia has an ancient history, unique wildlife and the oldest living culture in the world, yet 70% of species are still undescribed by western science, although the First peoples of Australia have known them for millennia. Life in Australia has been shaped by stable geology, continental drift, isolation and lack of glaciation to produce an extraordinary biodiversity. Australian ecologists Joshua, Mike, and Mandy Bamford will discuss the factors affecting the development of Australia's fauna, illustrated by the fauna studies that take them to remote corners of this ancient chunk of Gondwana.
