Week 3 Meeting: James Kempton

In December, James Kempton spent three weeks in Indonesia on a scouting mission in advance of his summer expedition to the Cyclops Mountains, New Guinea. In this talk, James will relay stories

of flying below the cloudline through the Heluk Valley, seeing birds-of-paradise on the slopes of the Cyclops, and meeting ambassadors in Jakarta. Through tales of the reconnaissance mission, James will highlight the benefits of reconnaissance, from logistics planning to permit acquisition, from publicity to building partnerships.

The following week, we will have a live stream from an [ongoing expedition by Carla V. Fuenteslópez to PRÍNCIPE](#) on 7/2/23.

Carla V Fuenteslópez, former Exploration Club Chairwoman and our current Archivist & Secretary, is leading the Oxford University Expedition to Príncipe island.

This unique place might even be “the only country in the world where precisely no archaeological fieldwork has yet been carried out” (Mitchell and Lunn-Rockcliffe 2021).

The team - Bastiaan, Denise, Sophia & Carla - are conducting the first deep-time sediment coring on the island to understand the dynamics of environmental change on the island and the influence of human occupation, performing contemporary biodiversity surveys in marine & terrestrial ecosystems, and sharing the stories and experiences of Principe's people. The expedition will also be featured in a documentary.
